

MISSOURI S&T UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH CONFERENCE

POSTER GUIDELINES

Poster Presentations:

- Students participating in the poster session are required to present a poster on the day of the research conference.
- Students giving poster presentations must be present at the location of their poster for an assigned time period. During this time, students will be required to give a brief presentation on their research poster and answer questions from the judges and conference attendees.

Poster Size:

- Posters may be no larger than 36" X 48". Average size is 36" x 48".

Poster Content Information:

There is no standard format for the poster layout. However, your poster content should include the following information:

Title: The title must be large enough to read from a distance. Your title area must include the authors. This will include your name, your faculty advisor's name and the department name (at a minimum). Other authors and the format for listing the authors are at the discretion of you and your faculty advisor.

Funding Source: It is appropriate to acknowledge your funding source on your poster (your internship information and your faculty advisor's grant funding source).
