VIRTUAL POSTER GUIDELINES

Virtual Poster Presentations:

- Students giving poster presentations must present their poster via zoom during their assigned time period. During this time, students will be required to give a brief presentation on their research poster and answer questions from the judges. You will share your screen to show your poster to the judges.
- You will be required to send a jpg/png picture of your poster to ugrc@mst.edu no later than April 12th.

Poster Size:

- You are NOT required to print your poster!
- You will present your poster through zoom from the program being used to create it.
- Posters may be no larger than 36" X 48". Average size is 36" x 48".

Poster Content Information:

There is no standard format for the poster layout. However, your poster content should include the following information:

Title: The title must be large enough to read from a distance. Your title area must include the authors. This will include your name, your faculty advisor's name and the department name (at a minimum). Other authors and the format for listing the authors are at the discretion of you and your faculty advisor.

Funding Source: It is appropriate to acknowledge your funding source on your poster (your internship information and your faculty advisor's grant funding source).
