MISCONDUCT: _____ is alleged to have violated Section 200.010(B) of the Collected Rules and Regulations of the University of Missouri by engaging in the following conduct for which students are subject to sanctions: _____

VIOLATION: 200.010 STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Standard of Conduct violations:

- 1) Academic dishonesty
a. Cheating
b. Plagiarism
c. Sabotage
2) Violation of University policies
3) Misuse in accordance with University policy of computing resources
a. Unauthorized entry into a file to use, read, or change the contents, or for any other purpose.
b. Unauthorized transfer of a file.
c. Use of computing facilities to interfere with the work of another student, faculty member, or university official

PROPOSED SANCTION: 200.020 STANDARD OF CONDUCT

- a. Warning. A notice in writing to the student that the student is violating or has violated institutional regulations.
b. Probation. A written reprimand for violation of specified regulations. Probation is for a designated period of time and includes the probability of more severe sanctions if the student is found to be violating any institutional regulation(s) during the probationary period.
c. Loss of Privileges. Denial of specified privileges for a designated period of time.
d. Discretionary Sanctions. Work assignments, service to the University, or other related discretionary assignments.
e. University Dismissal. An involuntary separation of the student from the institution for misconduct apart from academic requirements. It does not imply or state a minimum separation time.
f. University Suspension. Separation of the student from the University for a definite period of time, after which the student is eligible to return. Conditions for readmission may be specified.
g. University Expulsion. Permanent separation of the student from the University.

Primary Administrative Officer/Designee: Dr. Jeffrey Cawlfeld, Vice Provost for Undergraduate Studies

The Primary Administrative Officer/Designee has informed me that for the misconduct stated he proposed to impose the discipline stated above against me and that I have seven (7) calendar days in which to make a decision to accept this proposal or to reject this proposal by signing the rejection, thereby invoking formal procedures. He has further explained to me if I neither accept nor reject the proposed discipline within the period of time stated above, the proposed discipline shall become effective upon the expiration of that time.

I understand that I have a right to formal procedures prior to disposition if I reject the proposed discipline.

I accept the determination and proposed discipline stated above and waive my rights to formal procedures, review and appeal in this matter.
